

BP3905 Display of the United States Flag

Reference:

4 US Code Chapter 1

The United States “Flag Code” as found in Title 4 of the United States Code provides instructions on how to display the flag during its rendition. The “Flag Code” includes instructions and rules on such topics as the pledge of allegiance, display and use of the flag by civilians, time and occasions for display, position and manner of display, and how to show respect for the flag. The “Code” also grants to the President of the United States the authority to modify the rules governing the flag.

1. Display of the United States Flag

The United States flag will be displayed on District properties per the guidelines found in the associated administrative procedures.

2. Display of the California State Flag

The state flag of California shall be flown in a manner consistent with Federal, and State and District guidelines, as well as those found in the associated procedures.

3. Other Flags

Other flags may be flown on District flag poles, and at District events. Such displays will be consistent with the guidelines found in the associated administrative procedures.
