Recognition



COC Awarded \$5K Grant from the City of Santa Clarita

The **City of Santa Clarita** has generously awarded our Art Gallery with \$5K through the **2022 Community Services and Arts Grant** Program.

- Within our annual programming, the Gallery serves to foster a campus climate that champions *artistic excellence, anti-racist & equity-minded practice*, and expands *student access* to professional artists and their work.
- This grant will allow the Gallery to expand our **exhibitions** and **artist talks** to include both virtual and live events in our two gallery spaces – **Mentry 108** and **Library 206** – for our students, faculty, staff, patrons and community members.





Athletics Update



Cougars sports is back in full swing!

- **Men's Basketball** - COC has won **four** straight games heading into Wednesday's home contest vs. Glendale College. The final regular season game is 5 p.m. **Friday, Feb. 18** vs. Bakersfield in the Cougar Cage.
- **Women's Tennis** - COC was a **5-4** winner in its home opener vs. L.A. Mission College on Feb. 2nd and has since played to a 2-2 overall record in the early going with a **6-3** win over Santa Monica College its last time out. The Cougars are slated to play at Ventura on Tuesday before returning home for a Saturday morning match vs. Porterville College at 10 a.m
- **Men's Golf** - Canyons won the 2022 WSC Opener by 30 strokes over second place Santa Barbara City College on Monday at Valencia Country Club. COC was led by sophomore **Hugo Amsallem** who carded an even par **72** to earn medalist honors. Canyons had three players tie for the No. 3 spot in the individual standings



California LAW Diversity Champion Award for 2022

Last month COC received the **California LAW Diversity Champion Award** for 2022. The selection committee was very impressed with the great work we are doing with our students.

- The Award was established in 2008 by the **State Bar of California** to recognize the outstanding efforts of law-related educational programs that train and support students to become interested in the judicial system and careers in the law.
- This semester **131** students have self-identified as Pathway to Law school participants.
- Over the last four years, **303** students have participated in the Pathway to Law School program, with approximately **250** Pathway to Law classes being offered each semester.

2 NASA Missions for College of the Canyons!

COC's **Aerospace & Sciences Team** has been selected for both **NASA HASP** and **NASA RockSatX**. The student team competed with university teams from around the world and were selected for **both space missions**. These students are so motivated to persist, take initiative, and learn on their own, that the only barrier we face is that we lack the funding that the university teams all have.

- This will be our **6th NASA HASP** mission (2016, 2017, 2018, 2019, 2021, 2022).
- **1st year** being selected for a **large payload** spot on HASP & 1st time including student art.
- This will be our **3rd NASA RockSatX** mission (2019, 2021, 2022).
- **91** Internships/scholarships & **5** full-time careers to date – with 3 more in process!
- Our team represents a variety of backgrounds: Asian, African American, American Indian, Hispanic, Indian, Japanese, Korean, Mexican, and Middle Eastern. DEI in action!






What's New On And Around our Campuses

ISP Orientation



The **International Services & Programs (ISP)** held an orientation to welcome their new Spring 2022 students. We have welcomed **60** new students this spring! This is our **largest** cohort of incoming new ISP students.

- ISP students, as of Spring 2022, come from **40** countries, with **23** languages represented.
- As many of the new students are from Bangladesh, we connect them to the Islamic centers in town to foster a stronger sense of community for the students.

CCC Spring 2022 Highlights

- **Spring FLEX workshops** included a **Feb 2nd faculty and staff tour** of the Takeda Science Center, providing an opportunity to review the classrooms and resources of this facility.
- The CCC spring schedule includes **60 classes within the Science Center** as part of approx. **110 on-ground classes**. **71 faculty** are teaching at CCC in **20 disciplines** this semester.
- Construction of the **Learning Resources & Student Services Center** is expected to complete **Summer 2022**. This facility provides one-stop student support along with classrooms, tutoring, library, meeting, and study spaces.
- **Welcome Back activities** this week at CCC have included staff throughout campus with **AskMe** buttons/resources to assist students, followed by an engaging Welcome Week next week in coordination with **Campus Life & Student Engagement**.



Grant Development Update

Grants Progress

- **Grants Development** is busy this semester with applications planned for *Title V*, *Upward Bound Veterans*, *NSF*, and a variety of *STEM*, *Career Ed*, and *Workforce Engagement* opportunities.
- A highlight of a recent award is the **CCCCO California Apprenticeship Initiative (CAI)** grant awarded to COC in February for **\$250,000**. This opportunity will fund Construction Technology pre-apprenticeship to apprenticeship pathways in this in-demand field. Especial thanks to Amber Cole, Harriet Happel, Justin Wallace, and Carolyn Shaw for their efforts.
- The Grants Development team continues to work closely with many partners to support program needs and strategic goals. Current awards to-date for **FY21/22** total **\$10,011,620**.



Interim Multicultural Center



Our **Interim Multicultural Center** is set to open during February.

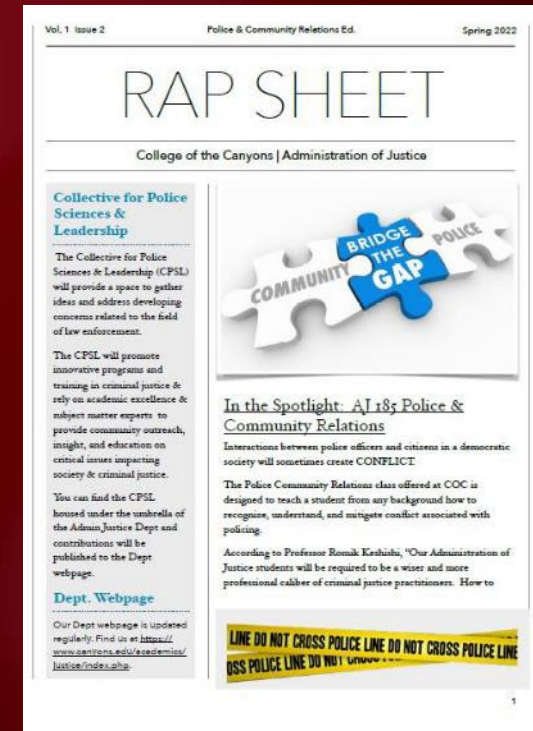
- Alliances will be able to meet in this space, open study space for students.
- Permanent Multicultural Center to be opened in Fall 2022 in this same space.
- The center will serve as:
 - A resource for the campus community while placing the experiences of diverse and historically minoritized and marginalized groups at the center.
 - A dynamic learning space with deliberate programming and opportunities to support all members of COC with the goal of increased engagement, retention and persistence of our diverse students.
 - A place to meet, build community, and serve as another access point/bridge to existing resources.
- In collaboration with constituents across the district, the Multicultural Center will be home to many alliance groups, the Undocucenter, group workshops, events, meeting rooms, open study space, counseling services, student services and college and community trainings.



Administration of Justice Newsletter

The COC Administration of Justice Program continues to promote our program offerings, our discipline, and the many associated careers by highlighting the Department in a positive light through a new newsletter, *The Rap Sheet*, which launched earlier this month. - Generate Campus wide interest and support for the Admin Justice program and our courses.



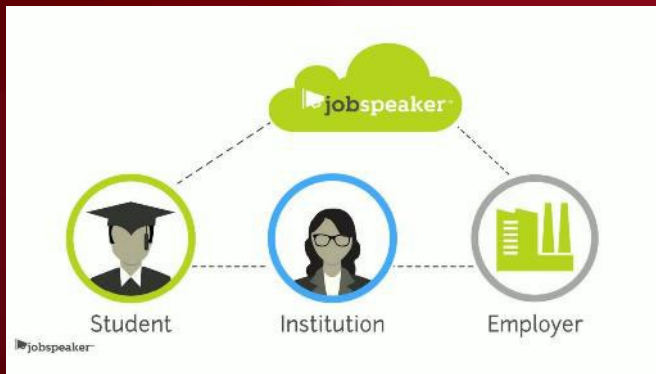
Reintroducing Paula Hodge: Our New Interim Director of Employer Engagement
