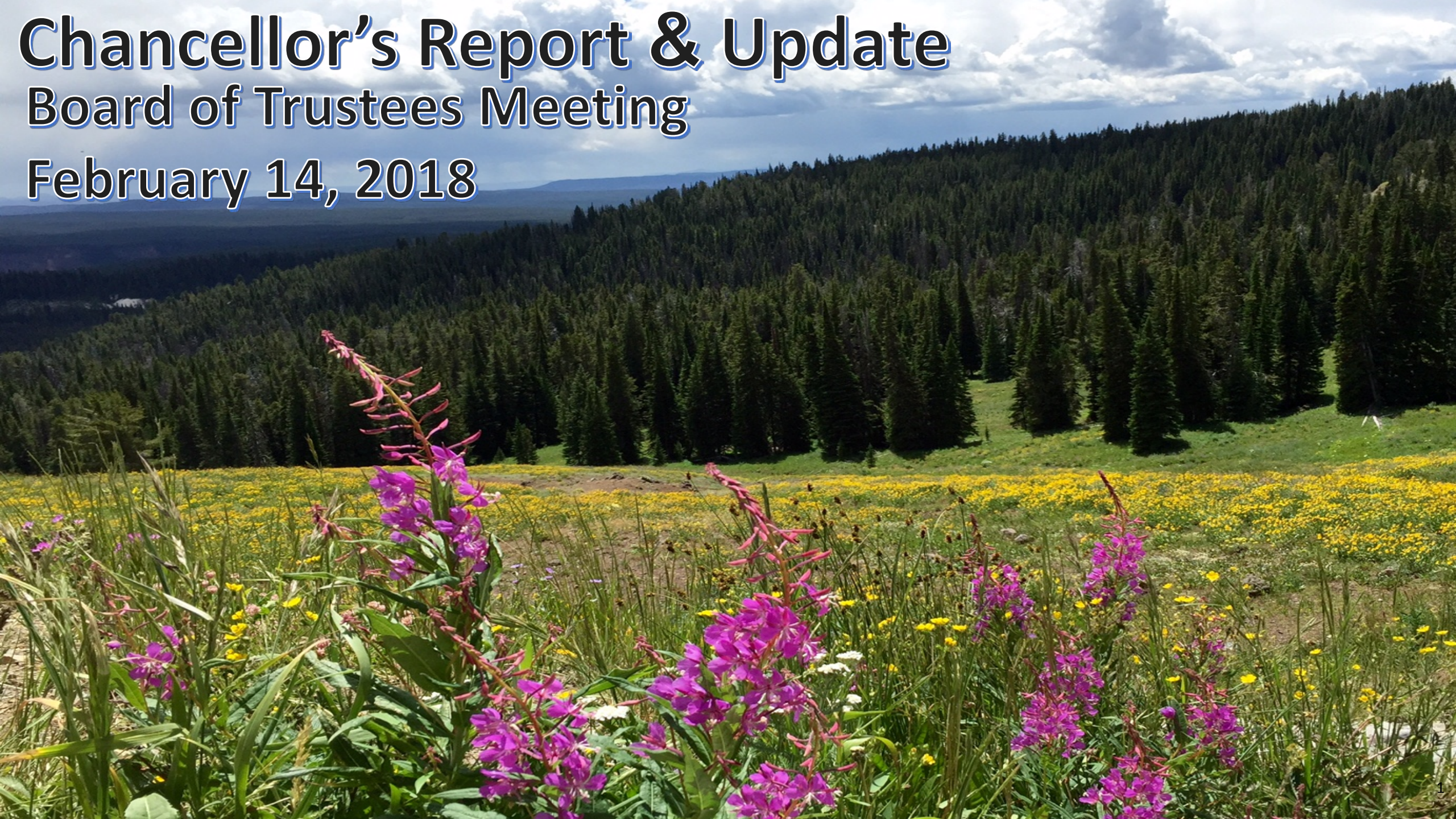

GREAT NEWS FROM THE ASTRONOMY PHYSICS CLUB!

Two teams of students have been working on proposals and designs for two different NASA student payloads (science experiments) and both teams have been accepted to participate!

- One of the projects will be manifested on **NASA's RockSatX** rocket which is set to launch in June 2018. This team successfully competed against universities across the nation and passed three design reviews of the payload.
- The second project was accepted for the **NASA High Altitude Student Platform (HASP)**. This team also competed against universities from across the nation. No other community college has ever flown on HASP **three times** and COC has been **selected three years in a row!** NASA HASP will launch in August/September 2018.
- We are incredibly proud of our students and of their amazing advisor Professor Teresa Ciardi.



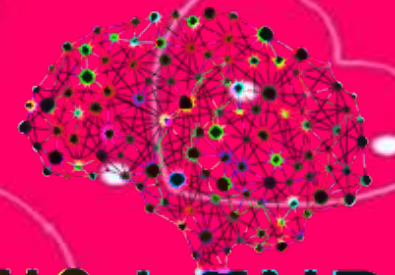

Nearly 60 local families attended the “*A Transition Odyssey*” conference that provided resources and information for parents of children with autism.

- Parents were able to attend a keynote address and break-out panel discussion during which they were able to ask questions to professionals that ranged from UCLA Medical School professors to Hart School District special needs coordinators.
- The conference focused on transition-aged individuals who are on the Autism Spectrum.
- This event was a great opportunity for parents to discover the resources that the SCV and Greater LA communities have to offer.
- COC worked in collaboration with UCLA and UCR on this conference which was a partnership between COC, JOY (Jewels of Youth Foundation) and UC-LEND (University of California Leadership Education in Neurodevelopmental and Other Related Disabilities).

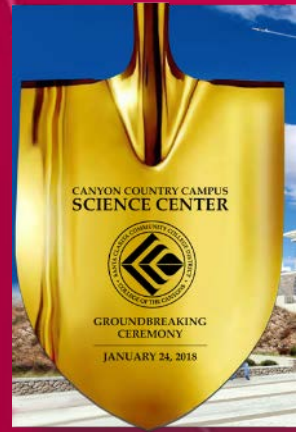

DONNA MILLER UPCOMING WORKSHOPS

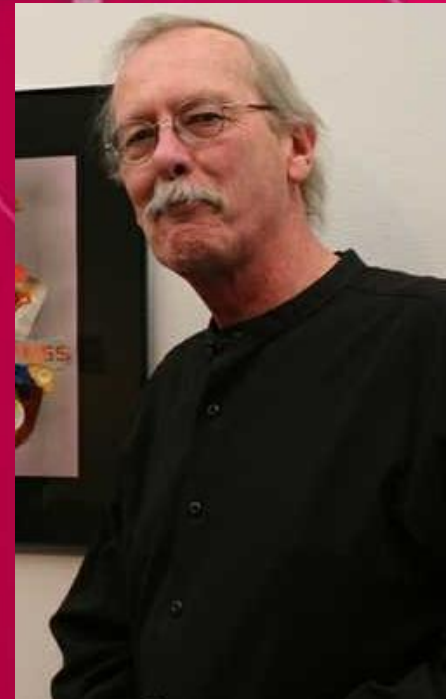
- Two workshops are scheduled with Donna Miller including:

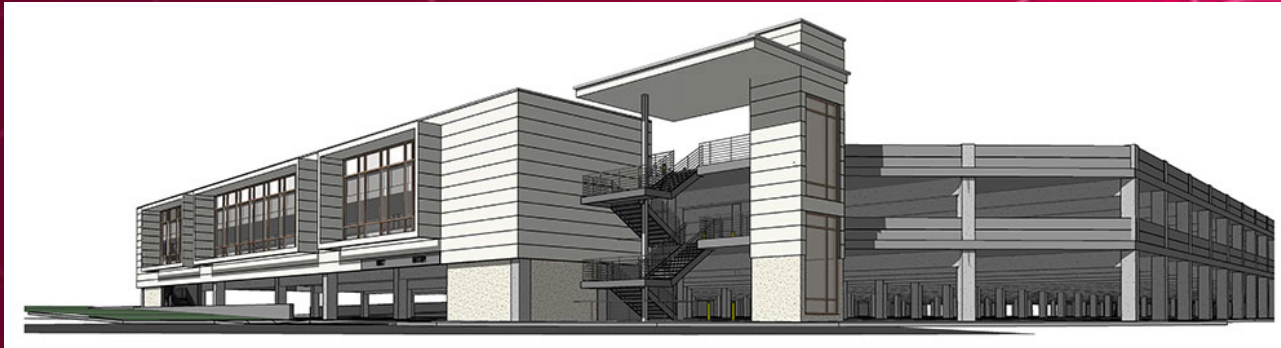

PARKING UPDATE

In anticipation of an impact to parking when construction of the new 1,659 space parking structure begins in March, we have taken several steps to address this temporary parking shortage:

- Parking in lot 2 is now temporarily designated for student and visitor parking, with a temporary staff lot created on the upper athletic field.
- All students may park **FREE** after 2 pm.
- More spaces have been added to parking lots 13 and 14.
- Parking lot 4 is now for car pools only.
- Students and staff can catch a ride with either LYFT or UBER and receive a \$5 discount to or from the Valencia campus.
- Beginning the first week of March, free parking will be available in an off-site lot, where students/staff can then get to campus via UBER or LYFT.
