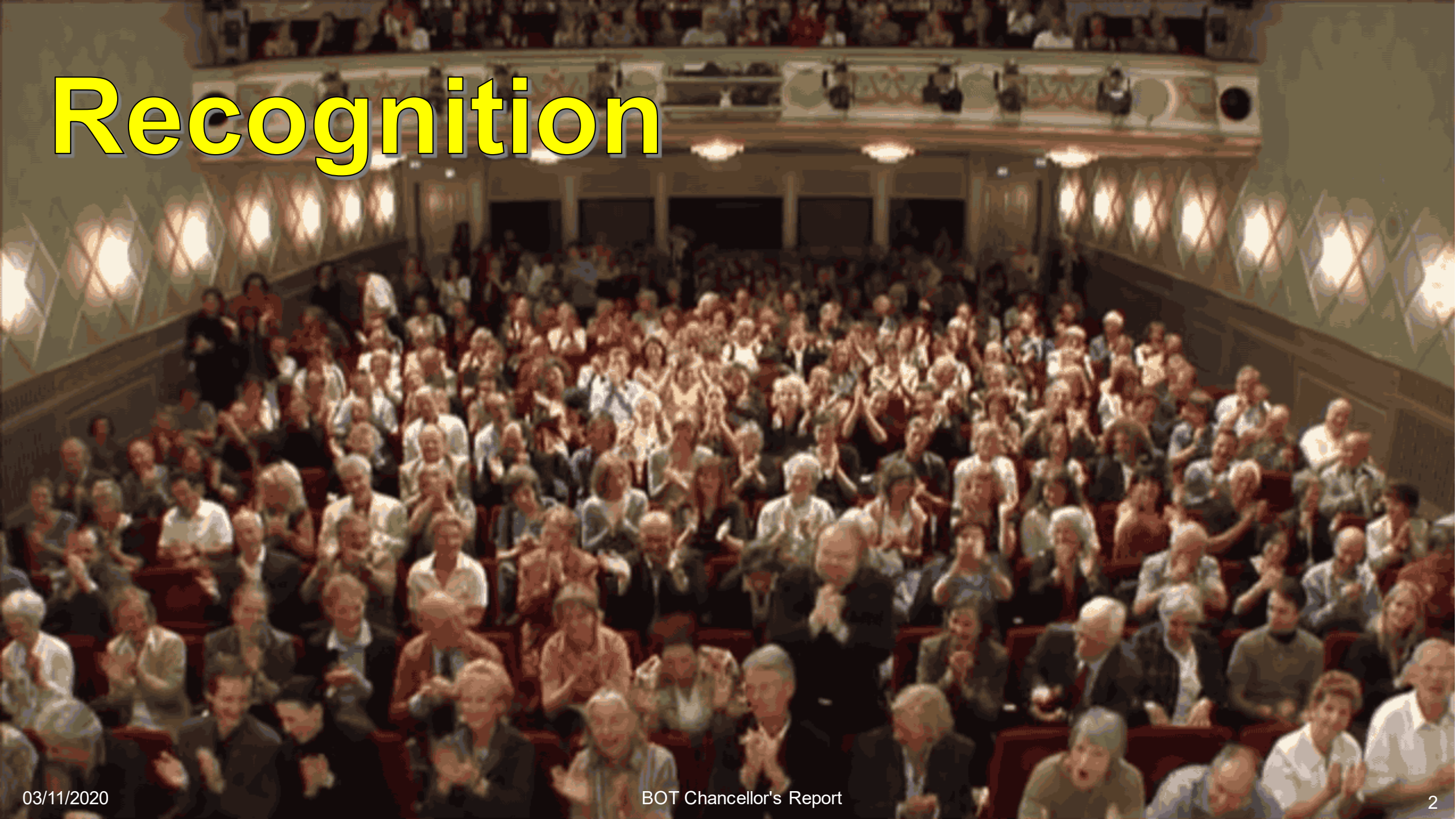

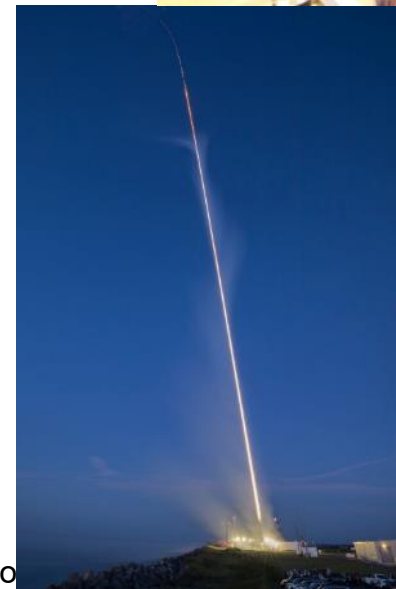

COC PAYLOAD MANIFESTED ON 2020 ROCKSAT-X

The Aerospace and Sciences Team successfully completed our **2020 NASA RockSatX STR** (Systems Test Review) on **Friday, February 21!**

- Our operational proto-type (3D printed in the Makerspace) was included in our presentation to the **NASA Program Manager** who was impressed by our progress and the overall design features of the system.
- Our team was invited to meet with **Stephanie English** and **Natalie Vartanian** in *Kathryn Barger's office* on Thursday, February 13 to show them our 2020 NASA RockSatX prototype, and we thanked the LA County Supervisors team for the **3 consecutive years of donations** to our team



JUST JAZZ TAKES OVER MIAMI

ON February 13-16, **Just Jazz** attended the *2nd Annual Vocal Jazz Invitational* at the *University of Miami* in Coral Gables, where our vocal team had the opportunity to network with the very best in the vocal jazz field.

COC RANKED AMONG TOP 25 COMMUNITY COLLEGES FOR HISPANICS

College of the Canyons has been ranked nationally **No. 22** in *The Hispanic Outlook in Higher Education Magazine* for enrolling the largest number of Hispanic students and granting the most degrees, respectively.

- “According to the data, the college had a Hispanic population of **10,004** students totaling **48 percent** of the total student enrollment, which was 20,850 in **fall 2018**.
- That same year, of the 2,601 associate degrees awarded by the college, **1,195** of degree recipients were Hispanic students.
- According to COC data, there was a **45 percent increase** in the number of Hispanic students who were awarded a degree *between 2016 and 2018*.



CONGRATULATIONS TO COC'S CA CAMPUS COMPACT STUDENT FELLOWS!

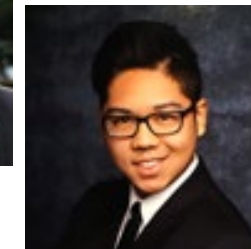

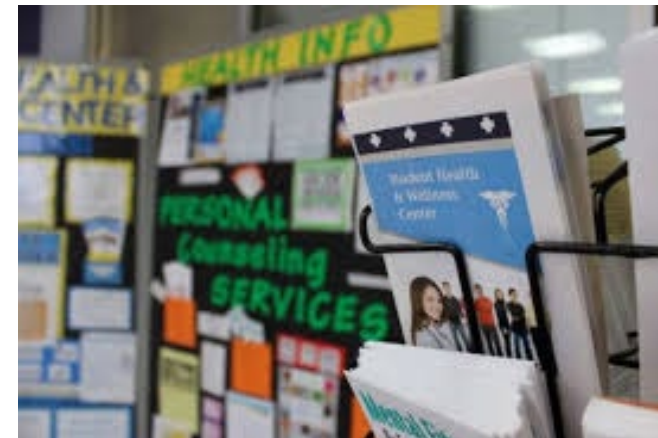

COC RECEIVES \$400K MENTAL HEALTH GRANT

The Santa Clarita Community College District has received a **\$400,000 grant** from the **California Community College Chancellor's Office** to *expand and enhance mental health services* and awareness to students and the campus community.

- The District was **1 of 16** to be awarded the **20-month grant**.
- The grant's primary goal is to *reduce racial disparities* in access to mental health services, and to provide **prevention, early intervention, and suicide prevention training**.
- The grant will allow the college to provide **personal counseling services** by increasing clinical hours and will fund the position of a mental health coordinator.



WHAT'S NEW IN ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT?

- We are launching the **second cohort** of the eight-month **Google IT Pre-apprenticeship Program**, designed to prepare students with the knowledge they need for entry-level IT positions.
- **Employee Training Institute (ETI)** is delivering **80 hours** of **CATIA training** to **20 Northrop Grumman** employees.
- ETI is provided **Sexual Harassment Prevention Training** to Supervisors and employees of **Bluemark**, a local on-boarding service provider.

ETI is partnering with **Carousel Ranch** to offer two programs in the areas of **Warehouse Fulfillment & Logistics** and **Customer Service, Hospitality, Retail & Restaurant**.

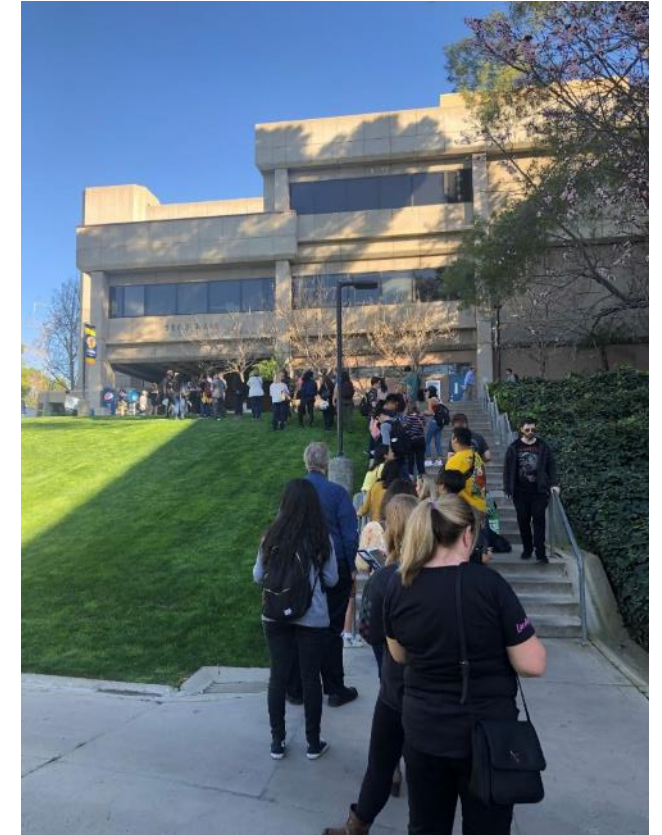
- **21 residents** are participating.

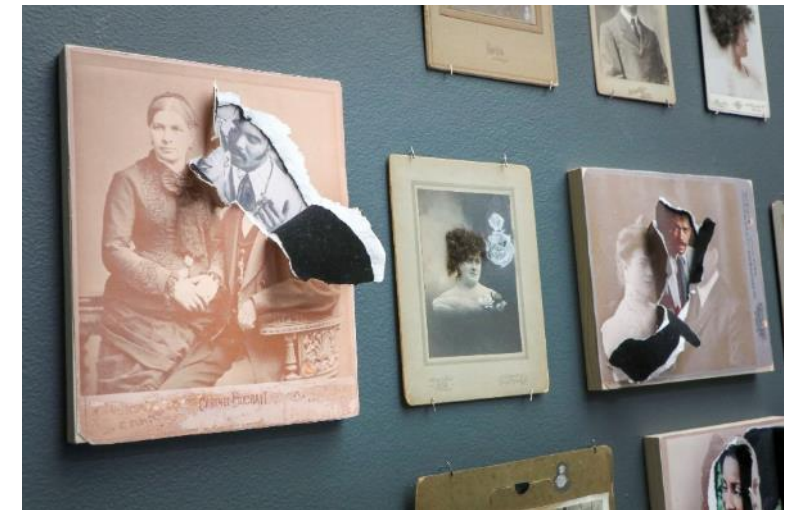
