This program reflects a regular concern from Police and Fire training/academy staff and recruiters that many applicants are ill prepared for the physical components of the Police and Fire Academies. Academy training staff have repeatedly indicated that physical fitness is the top disqualifier from the Police and Fire Academies. These professions require peak human physical and mental performance. It is therefore critical that our pre-service students understand and build upon the foundations of healthy lifestyles in order to meet or exceed the physical fitness requirements of Public Safety careers.
